The Holy Spirit is the **best gift** that God has given to His children, for all things of the Father come to His children through the Holy Ghost. This is not an exclusion of Christ because we already have received the Spirit of Christ when His Spirit is entwined with our spirit, for our new spiritual birth into the Kingdom.

But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? Even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. Which things also we speak, not in words which man's wisdom teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. 1 Corinthians 2:9-13

Christ is the Living Word, the spoken Word of God, for God spoke His creation into existence. The Holy Spirit is the <u>whole</u> Word of God living within each believer. The Holy Spirit teaches the Word of God (Scriptures) and manifests all God's gifts (provisions) into our life. Born in Christ and with the Holy Spirit we are complete for the Father.

But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also **quicken your mortal bodies** by his Spirit that dwelleth in you. Romans 8:11

Living with the Holy Spirit

1) Quicken the Holy Spirit within yourself.

If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the **Holy Spirit** to them that ask him? Luke 11:13

Father, thank you for sending your Son to free me from the bondage of sin, and as I am reborn in Christ, I am also thankful for the gift of the Holy Spirit. I come before you asking that the Holy Ghost be awakened within me, so that I may live and serve according to your Word. On the name of Christ and the blood He shed at Calvary for me, I pray, Amen.

2) The Holy Spirit bears witness that we are the children of God.

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry Abba, Father. **The Spirit beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God.** Romans 8:14-16

3) The Holy Spirit is <u>our tutor</u> who gives us knowledge, wisdom, and the understanding of God's Word.

<u>Wisdom and Knowledge</u>: But the Comforter, which is the **Holy Ghost**, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall **teach** you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. John 14:26

4) The Holy Spirit is our <u>advocate</u> within the Kingdom of Heaven.

Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. Romans 8:26

5) The Holy Spirit gives gifts which are wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, miracles, prophecy, discerning of spirits, speaking in tongues, and interpretation of tongues.

But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will. I Corinthians 12:7-11

6) The Holy Spirit gives us a <u>spiritual language</u>.

Speaking in Tongues: For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries. 1 Corinthians 14:2

For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful. What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also. 1 Corinthians 14:14-15

Wherefore tongues are for a sign, not to them that believe, but to them that believe not: but prophesying serveth not for them that believe not, but for them which believe. 1 Corinthians 14:22

7) <u>Interpretation of Tongues:</u> He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church. I would that ye shall all spake with tongues, but rather that ye prophesied: for greater is he that prophesieth than he that speaketh with tongues, except he *interpret*, that the church may receive edifying.1 Corinthians 14:4-5

8) The Holy Spirit give us <u>faith</u>.

To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit. 1 Corinthians 12:9

9) The Holy Spirit gives us <u>supernatural power</u>.

But you shall **receive power**, after that the **Holy Ghost** is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. Acts 1:8

10) The Holy Spirit requires we <u>live with the Fruits of the Spirit</u> which are love, joy, peace, faith, gentleness, goodness, meekness, temperance and longsuffering.

But the **fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. Galatians 5:22-23

Though told to His disciples by Christ, it holds true today to all the believers. We have the anointing of the Holy Spirit to reach out to the world in belief, trust, and faith in the gospel of Christ.

Holy Spirit Gifts

The gifts operate as we follow the Holy Spirit. Meaning, as we posture ourselves to receive, the gifts will *flow like living waters*.

We must present ourselves with belief, trust, and faith confident in our relationship with the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost. When we do, there are spiritual gifts from the trinity. The Holy Spirit gifts are of power which is why it is vital to have the Holy Spirit quickened that we may receive what God has set forth for us. The Holy Spirit's gifts are wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, miracles, prophecy, discerning of spirits, speaking in tongues, and interpretation of tongues. But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will. 1 Corinthians 12:7-11 Notice that healing and miracles are forthcoming from the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit dwells within our heart and when we hear from God, the communion is of the heart before His Word takes hold in our mind as a thought. Logically, it would seem a thought would appear in our mind before the heart's discernment, but not so. For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people. Hebrews 8:10 Therefore, Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. Hebrews 10:22 When a thought enters our mind before the heart's conception, it would be our own self effort. We should listen carefully to not miss what the Holy Spirit is teaching us.

Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groaning which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God. Romans 8:26-27

If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the **Holy Spirit to them that ask him?** Luke 11:13

Our prayers petitioned on the authority of Christ are fulfilled through the Holy Spirit when we ask according to His Word. And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye ask any thing in my name, I will do it. John 14:13-14

Holy Spirit Power

The Holy Ghost's gifts are for our use to glorify God and the marvelous benefit is to have them for our daily earthen life.

Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will **guide** you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself, but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will show you things to come. John 16:13

But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall **teach** you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. John 14:26

<u>Wisdom and Knowledge</u>: To know **wisdom** and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding; To receive the instruction of **wisdom**, justice, and judgment, and equity. Proverbs 1:2-3

Miracles and Healing: And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing it shall not hurt them; they shall **lay hands on the sick**, and they **shall recover**. Mark 16:17-18

Speaking in Tongues: For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries. 1 Corinthians 14:2

<u>Prophecy</u>: But he that **prophesieth** speaketh unto men to edification, and exhortation, and comfort. 1 Corinthians 14:3

Speaking in the Spiritual Language

Praying in tongues is an unselfish prayer, for we do not know what or whom we are praying for. It is a supernatural language between the Holy Spirit and God (even though God is the Holy Spirit). Speaking in tongues is the sword of God working on our behalf.

And take the helmet of salvation, and the **sword of the Spirit**, which is the **word of God**: praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; And for me, that utterance may be given unto me,

that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel, For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak. Ephesians 6:17-20

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Living Waters

He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly **shall flow rivers of living** waters. John 7:39

A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit. Proverbs 15:4

And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as a fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were filled with the Holy Ghost, and began speaking with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. Acts 2:1-4

Fruit of the Spirit
