Secrets to Supernatural Success

Our desire to achieve is a natural response to society's recipe for success. We all strive for the accomplishments that reveal a measurement of success whether it be in relationships with our spouse, children, family members, and friends. We all want our time spent with others to be acceptable, loving, and joyous. We work diligently to reach a platform of achievement in our career choices. By human nature, we structure our lifestyles by these standards.

However, what if you were to discover a secret for supernatural success that supercharges everything you do with unimaginable benefits? Wouldn't you want to learn more and have the opportunity to live a lifestyle with unprecedented power and prosperity along with the ability to share it? This is not a fairytale, but a truth. It can be a reality in your life and is available to you, right now. So you say: *I want this; how do I get in on such a fabulous offering?*

It's simple and free. There are no clubs to join, no membership fees, and no monetary obligations. The only thing that is required is your participation; your desire to want it and agreement to live it. It can't get any easier than this. Supernatural success is a gift to you from your heavenly Father. The gift comes with a name and message just like a tangible present has a bow and card attached, thus, this spiritual gift does also. The tag reads, *Holy Spirit* and the card says, *supernatural blessings and power*, signed *your loving Father*. Wow! What an amazing and undeserving gift, but you know you want it.

There is one problem, unlike a physical box to unwrap, you don't know how to release the contents of your present. When you are reborn in Christ, the Father gives you a gift, but you haven't received any instructions on how to *open* it. As all things of God are spiritual, so is your gift. But how are you going to attain the supernatural resources?

Typically, most people accept Christ in the presence of others, say in a church environment. If the baptism of the Holy Spirit is not explained upon your rebirth in Christ into the spirit realm, you will leave the fellowship having not *opened* your spiritual gift. You may not be aware of your gift, or if you have a faint understanding of the Holy Spirit, you may be uncertain how to accept Him in your life, or that it is even necessary to do so.

The other scenario is accepting Christ while alone in the privacy of your home, or sitting in your automobile at a stop sign. While either is perfectly acceptable to God, if you haven't been enlightened to the necessity to quicken (awaken) the Holy Spirit, you will be remiss in receiving the benefits of your supernatural gift. It is at this juncture, that many believers lose out on the treasures that are available through the Holy Spirit. It is on Christ's authority, but it is through the Holy Spirit that we receive.

Lets take a moment and start at the beginning. Christ purchased and washed you clean of sin with His blood, and on the cross upon His death took your unrighteousness (sins) to His carnal death. Once you make the decision and desire to return to the Kingdom, accepting God as your heavenly Father, and Christ, His Son who came to earth for you, then you are reborn a spirit person in Christ for the Father. With a prayer of acceptance and forgiveness of sins, you are returned to the Kingdom.

You are now officially a spirit person living in a physical body, in a natural world, just like Adam and Eve. They were spirit beings in physical bodies living in a natural world, but they spent their time in communion with God, continuously. We should be experiencing the same relationship with God because He made it possible. It is immensely significant to digest this one spiritual truth. God wants you and when you accept Him, you are His child.

Next, we must acknowledge the magnitude of the Trinity as God presents Himself to man as revealed in the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost. The Trinity has a specific purpose for man and once we understand this, we are better prepared to accept God's plan for our life. Without the Trinity of God, we remain prodigal children wandering aimlessly in a fallen world. Even if you have accepted Christ and no longer live in sin, you can still remain without heavenly benefits and power, simply by not having the Holy Spirit actively present in your life. It is crucial to understand the roles of Christ and the Holy Spirit.

With the knowledge of how God presents Himself as the Trinity, we acknowledge in our desire to return to the Kingdom that we have two-parts of God within our life. First, we have Christ's spirit entwined birthing our spirit, and on His authority, we are sent the Holy Spirit, our gift. And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you forever; Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. John 14:16-17 You have God living on the inside of you, in your heart. You are free of the bondage that held you captive and returned to the Father. Again, this is the juncture that many fall short.

Up to this point, you should have a clear acceptance of God's purpose of the Trinity. But what about the third-person, the Holy Ghost, the gift? The Holy Ghost doesn't seem to get much recognition as doctrines settle on Christ and little if any attention is given to the Holy Spirit. However, nothing comes from God but through the Holy Spirit. Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. Romans 8:26 God's Word tells us that the Holy Ghost is our channel of communication to Him, for He is our tutor, our confidant, and our advocate before the throne. If you want a healing, prosperity, a better job, or a prayer answered, then you must have the Holy Spirit representing you in the Kingdom, speaking on your behalf.

In accepting the Trinity of God and understanding the purpose of the deities, lets rightfully focus on the Holy Ghost where privilege and power prevail to each person born of Christ. God's

reason for giving Himself in the person of the Holy Ghost is to provide a means of communicating directly with Him, and whereby we can receive His gifts and power. It is not until we pass from this earthen life into eternity that we will stand before God. However, until that time, the Holy Spirit stands in our place. God gives us a spiritual spokesperson who is our advocate making our prayers know to the Father. How absolutely awesome is that! God has given us a way to speak to Him!

Christ had a very definitive destiny to fulfill for the Father; reclaim God's children and return them to the Kingdom. We know how this was accomplished. The Holy Spirit also has a defined purpose and that is to connect us to our Father. It is on the authority that Christ gives us as He sits at the right hand of the Father that we are allowed to approach God. An analogy would be like a referral for a job interview. You get the interview appointment based on being permitted to use a specific person's name. They are vouching for your abilities for the position. Likewise, Christ is giving us His authority to speak to the King, our Father. This is why when we pray, we conclude our prayer: "on the authority in Christ and through the Holy Spirit, Amen." This is the two persons of the Trinity that God has provided of Himself for man. In not understanding the role of the Holy Spirit, and submitting our prayers only on Christ's name will not get answers. Why? Because it requires both the second and third person of the deity of God to reach the Father. God set it up this way. Jesus has his role, and the Holy Ghost has His and it requires both of them to have communion with God. One grants the authority while the other is the spokesperson. If you have been praying solely in Christ and not through the One who is your spokesperson within the Kingdom, then you may be missing on everything the Father has for you in treasures, supernatural power, and answered prayers.

The secret to supernatural success is the Holy Spirit. If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him? Luke 11:13 Understanding how God provides Himself to man in Christ and the Holy Spirit, and the purpose of each enables us to know how the Kingdom functions. In knowing this, we learn how to reach the Father through the persons of Trinity. Remember, one returns us to the Father and gives His permission to use Him as a reference, while the other is our advocate, spokesperson, for as long as we remain living in a physical body. Christ grants His authority, but it is the Holy Spirit who fulfills prayers and releases supernatural power from Heaven.

It is supernaturally awesome to know that right now you are connected to God! He is always available for His children and is pleased when you seek Him through the Holy Spirit, for He is your direct connection to the Father.

Steps to Supernatural Success

Simple steps to your supernatural success.

• Quicken or activate the gift of the Holy Spirit, who lives in your heart. This requires acknowledgement through a prayer.

Father, thank you for sending your Son to free me from the bondage of sin, and as I am reborn in Christ, I am also thankful for the gift of the Holy Spirit. I come before you asking that the Holy Ghost be awakened within me, so that I may live and serve according to your Word. On the name of Christ and the blood He shed at Calvary for me, I pray, Amen.

- Now you have the Holy Spirit awakened in you and He is ready to work on your behalf.
- Understand the Trinity of God. Know the roles of Christ, and the Holy Spirit, and the purpose they represent in your life.
- Accept the Holy Spirit as your best friend, confidant, protector, advisor, and direct advocate before God.
- Study the Scriptures, learn God's Word as the Holy Spirit is your tutor and will decipher the parables for you teaching you all things of the Kingdom of Heaven.
- Live by the Fruits of the Spirit, the precepts (laws) that the Holy Spirit requires of you. Remember, though you remain in a physical body, you are a spirit person. Be guided by the Spirit of Truth in all matters concerning your life.
- Study the nine specific gifts that are granted from the Holy Spirit. Pray to the Holy Spirit for those gifts you wish to have. As you mature, He will know when you are prepared to receive and use His gifts wisely. Some gifts are automatically given, while others take in-depth knowledge of God's Word in preparation to receive.
- Be in constant communication with your best friend, the Holy Spirit. Rely on Him, for He lives in you for this very reason. Listen to His voice and following His teachings. He has been given to you and will never forsake you.
- The Holy Spirit will be your spokesperson before God, provide answered prayers, and give heavenly treasures and supernatural power. Trust Him explicitly.

- In accepting Christ and the Holy Spirit for a relationship with the Father, the trinity of man which is body, soul, and spirit comes full circle. For we begin, born of the Spirit (made in God's likeness), born of the womb into a physical world, and reborn in the spirit (in Christ) for our returning to the Father. Our existence begins in the spirit and returns to the spirit.
- Be prepared to live as a spirit person, in the spirit realm, for the Spirit of God. The Spirit of Truth, the Holy Ghost, makes it possible while you remain on earth.

Don't wait until you pass from this earthen life into eternity to begin living as a spirit person in the Kingdom. God made it possible that you could begin the moment you were reborn in Christ. You are already home in the Kingdom of Heaven, if you only know how to live it.
